DIAGNOSIS

TETRALOGY OF FALLOT

PROCEDURE PERFORMED: TRANS RA COMPLETE REPAIR OF TOF

CLINICAL HISTORY

History:

Virat is 8 month male, infant from Bihar presenting with severe cyanosis and near spell like episodes. Echo revealed the above diagnosis. Parents are counseled about the risk/benefits of the procedure during consent.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

General Examination:

Child was conscious, oriented, afebrile.

Cyanosis present.

No pallor, icterus, clubbing, lymphadenopathy or oedema.

Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear, bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze.

CVS - S1 normal. S2 loud. Systolic murmur heard.

P/A - Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. No hepatosplenomegaly. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious and oriented. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation. Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

CLINICAL SUMMARY

Child was taken for OT after complete pre OP evaluation. Child tolerated the procedure well and shifted to PCS ICU after the procedure. Child remained hemodynamically stable post op was started on oral feeds and weaned off O2 support. At the time of discharge patient was afebrile, hemodynamically stable and maintaining saturation at room air.

DISCHARGE ADVICE

SYP EUROPED 0.8 ML PO BD

TAB ALDACTONE (25MG) 1/4TH TAB PO OD

TAB CARDIOVAS (3.125MG) 1/4TH TAB PO BD

SYP CALCIMAX PLUS 5 ML PO BD FOR 4 WEEKS

SYP PARACETAMOL (120MG/5ML) 5 ML PO TDS FOR 3 DAYS THEN SOS
