LARGE PDA

Procedure done- PDA DEVICE CLOSURE

CLINICAL HISTORY

Chief Complaints:

History:

1 year old child presented with history of recurrent chest infections. 2D Echo revealed above diagnosis. Risks/benefits were explained while taking consent

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

General Examination:

Child was conscious, oriented, afebrile.

No pallor, icterus, clubbing, cyanosis, lymphadenopathy or oedema.

Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze.

CVS - Heart sounds normal. Pan systolic murmur heard.

P/A -Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. No hepatosplenomegaly. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious and oriented. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation. Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

CLINICAL SUMMARY

After relevant preoperative workup, patient was taken up for PDA device closure. Patient tolerated the procedure well and was shifted to PCS ICU for monitoring. Post procedure, child remained hemodynamically stable. Child had global developmental delay with microcephaly for which regular followup with pediatric neurologist has been advised. At time of discharge, patient is hemodynamically stable, on room air, accepting feeds well orally and passing adequate urine.

DISCHARGE ADVICE

1- SYP FUROPED 0.5 ML PO TWICE DAILY AT 7AM, 7PM

2- SYP PCM (5ml/120mg) 4ML SOS FOR PAIN

3- SYP CALCIMAX 5ML PO OD

4- COLLECT PENDING REPORT (TFT REPORT SEND ON 22/10/2017)
