DIAGNOSIS

LARGE PATENT DUCTUS ARTERIOSUS WITH MODERATE AR WITH SEVERE PAH
SP- PDA device closure

CLINICAL HISTORY

Chief Complaints:

Recurrent pneumonias since 6 months of age

History:

Child was admitted with history of recurrent episodes of pneumonia since 6 months of age.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

General Examination:

Child was conscious, afebrile.

PR- 110/min, RR- 28/min , spO₂- 97%

Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze.

CVS - Heart sounds normal. Murmur heard in left infraclavicular area

P/A -Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious ,active, alert. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation. Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

CLINICAL SUMMARY

Child was admitted with above mentioned complaints. Transesophageal ECHO was done to confirm the above mentioned diagnosis. After appropriate workup, PDA device closure by cardiac catheterization. Post procedure child was shifted to ICU. Child was hemodynamically stable. Child was on oxygen by mask which was tapered off to room air.

At discharge, child is hemodynamically stable, on room air and orally accepting well.

DISCHARGE ADVICE

Tab Aldactone (25 mg) 1/4 th tab once a day - 12 PM

Syp Eupred 0.8 ml twice a day - 10 AM and 10 PM

Tab Envas (2.5 mg) 1/3 rd tab twice a day 8 AM and 8 PM

Syp PCM (120 mg/5ml) 5 ml SOS for pain or fever
