**DIAGNOSIS**

DIAGNOSIS- ASD WITH TINY PDA  
PROCEDURE PERFORMED- ASD DEVICE CLOSURE

**CLINICAL HISTORY**

**History:**

3 years 8 Months old female was incidentally diagnosed to have 8 mm ASD with tiny PDA. Parents were counselled about the risk / benefits of the procedure and child was posted for ASD device closure with cardiac cath

**PHYSICAL EXAMINATION**

General Examination:

Weight 11.2 kg

Child was conscious, oriented, afebrile.

No pallor, icterus, clubbing, cyanosis, lymphadenopathy or oedema.

Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze.

CVS - Heart sounds normal systolic murmur heard.

P/A -Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. No hepatosplenomegaly. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious and oriented. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation: Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

**CLINICAL SUMMARY**

Child was taken for device closure after complete workup. Child tolerated the procedure well and was shifted to ICU post procedure. Child remained hemodynamically stable, was started on oral feeds and is planned for discharge.
