DIAGNOSIS

P/M VSD (5MM)
PROCEDURE DONE: VSD DEVICE CLOSURE

CLINICAL HISTORY

History:

Aditya is 7 year old male child who is a known case of perimembranous VSD with history of recurrent chest infection, is now admitted for device closure. Risk/benefits of the procedure has been explained to parents while taking written consent.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

General Examination:

Child was conscious, oriented, afebrile.
No pallor, icterus, clubbing, cyanosis, lymphadenopathy or oedema.

Systemic examination:

RS - Chest clear bilaterally. Air entry equal. No crepitations or wheeze.

CVS - Heart sounds normal. Pan systolic murmur heard.

P/A - Abdomen is soft, not tender and not distended. No hepatosplenomegaly. Bowel sounds are normal.

CNS - Child was conscious and oriented. Muscle tone and reflexes are normal. Plantars are down-going. No signs of meningeal irritation. Pupils are normal sized and normally reactive to light bilaterally

CLINICAL SUMMARY

After appropriate pre operative workup, child was taken for cath procedure. Child tolerated the procedure well and shifted to PCS ICU for monitoring. Child remained hemodynamically stable post procedure. At discharge, child hemodynamically well, on room air, afebrile, accepting feeds well and passing urine adequately.

DISCHARGE ADVICE

1. TAB ECOSPRIN (75MG) 1 TAB PO ONCE A DAY AT 7AM FOR 6 MONTHS
2. TAB RANITIDINE (150MG) 1/2 TAB ONCE A DAY AT 6AM
3. SYP BEVON 5ML PO ONCE A DAY
